Twelve physicians with varying specialties, and an all-star team of certified athletic trainers, physical therapists and nurses form the backbone of the Sports Medicine Center of Bienville Orthopaedic Specialists program.

Bienville Orthopaedic Specialists, which provides the physicians, is the second largest orthopaedic practice in the state, behind the University of Mississippi Medical Center in Jackson. The athletic training staff of 11, all of which are certified and licensed athletic trainers employed by Encore Rehabilitation, is the largest physical therapy and athletic training company in Mississippi.

The Sports Medicine Center of Bienville Orthopaedic Specialists is the sports medicine team for Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College and twelve (12) high schools across the coast. We conduct approximately **1,500 free** athletic physicals every year.

During **Football Season** (August 22nd - November 7th) we provide a **free** Saturday morning sports injury clinic for high school and college athletes at our Cedar Lake location. Our physicians are on the sidelines of every home game as a free service to our young athletes in the community.
