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Instructions for the care of Surgical and/or Biopsy sites

- 1. Remove the bandage after 6-12 hours and keep the site uncovered.**
The open air will heal the site faster. If you have to cover the site (for social obligations), you may do so for a short period.
- 2. With a Q-Tip, apply 3% Hydrogen Peroxide, three times a day for one week.**
- 3. The site will form a crust on it and will fall off in one to two weeks.**
- 4. If the area is sore, apply Polysporin Ointment** (this is available without a prescription), three times a day for four to seven days.

You will receive a bill from the laboratory (affiliated with your insurance company). We will provide them with your insurance information, they will file with your Insurance Company and then balance bill you. If you have any questions about their bill please call them directly.
