Keep Your Home Safe From Burglars

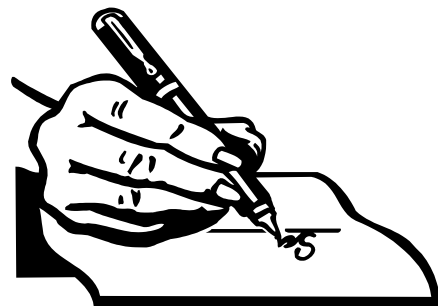

Barbeque Safety For Cooking Outdoors

One of the great pleasures of summer is eating and cooking outdoors with family and friends. Cooking on outdoor grills or barbecues can be fun, but they can also be dangerous. Please remember these safety tips:

- Never use charcoal barbecues in an enclosed space. Combustion of charcoal emits carbon monoxide gas, which is very dangerous.
 - Don't be tempted on a rainy day to use outdoor cooking equipment inside, not even in a garage or on a porch or balcony.
 - Once you have the fire started, DO NOT add starter fluid. This can cause the fire to spread and become very dangerous.
- Use caution when disposing of ashes. Ashes may contain live coals, which can start a fire. Wet ashes thoroughly with water before emptying them.
 - ALWAYS BE PREPARED FOR THE UNEXPECTED.
 - HAVE A SAFETY DEVICE READY IN CASE THE FIRE GETS OUT OF HAND!!!!!!
